SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- The scholarship is for study at any accredited post-secondary institution, including two and four year colleges and universities and vocational and technical schools.
- The scholarship is for persons between 17 and 24 who will be full-time students entering or already enrolled in a post-secondary education program.
- Final award is contingent on admission and paid to the school directly for a post-secondary education program for the school year starting in September 2026.
- Use the checklist on page 2 to complete all application information.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Your parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be enrolled in or have graduated from Home Forward's GOALS program. In addition, they must currently reside in a Home Forward residence or a Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) participant in good standing.
- If you are the head of household, are age 17-24 and meet the qualifications above, you also may apply.
- If you are in high school, you must be in your senior year and have a 3.0 grade point average. If you are already in a post-secondary education program, you must have a 2.75 grade point average as applicable.
- If you did not graduate from high school, you must have completed a GED program.
- You must write an essay about your educational goals and provide two community or school references.

STEVE RUDMAN OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP FACT AND TIP SHEET

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- Youth between 17-24 may apply if their family participates in or has graduated from the agency's GOALS self-sufficiency program and is in good standing with Home Forward.
- The \$2,500 award is for the school year or term that begins in September 2026. The recipient may renew the scholarship for a second year for up to the same amount, if eligibility requirements are maintained.
- The scholarship can be used for post-secondary education at accredited two- and four-year colleges and universities and trade and vocational schools.
- Home Forward staff are not eligible for the scholarship.

SELECTION PROCESS

- The recipient will be chosen by a committee comprised of Steve Rudman, a post-secondary academic leader, two Home Forward commissioners, and the Home Forward staff person responsible for education initiatives.
- The committee will consider academic achievement, leadership, participation in activities helpful to others, and post-secondary education goals.

TIPS

- 1** After submitting all the pieces of your application, check in with Home Forward to make sure that all of your documents have arrived.

- 2** If you complete your application online, do not forget to attach 2 recommendation letters and school transcripts.
- 3** Ask for your transcripts right away. It can take some schools a month to be able to get your transcripts in the mail, so give yourself plenty of time.
- 4** Utilize your family's GOALS case manager for support as needed.
- 5** If your GPA is lower than the criteria threshold (3.0 for high school students and 2.75 for college students), you can obtain a letter from a school counselor or your GOALS coordinator explaining why your application should be considered.
